



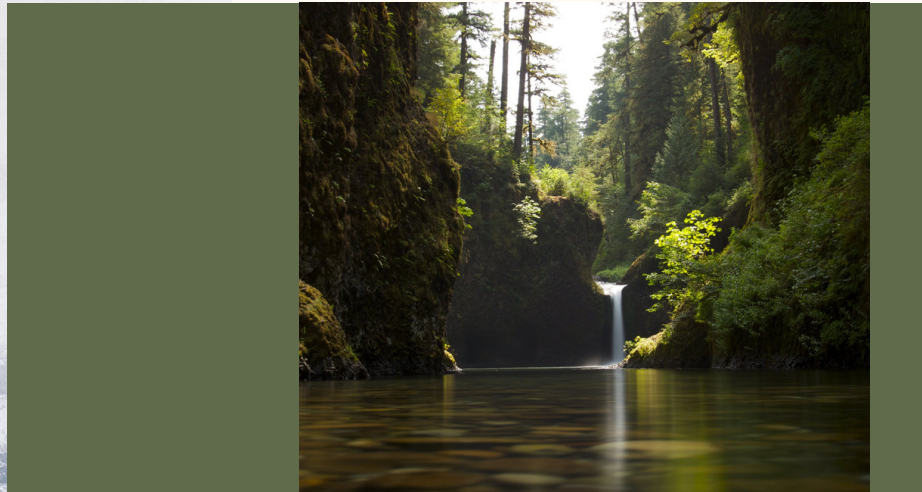
SPIRIT OF THE WILD EUROPE
